- Collective Boards** In the early stages of a grassroots organization the structure is usually that of a collective. A collective board has no management hierarchy. Board volunteers (and staff, if any) share responsibility for all facets of the organization.
- Working/Administrative Boards** As the organization grows, the next stage is usually that of a working board. Often there is no executive director or chief operating officer, meaning the chair of the board generally takes the lead role. At this stage, various committees are formed drawing on a larger body of volunteers.
- Policy Governance — Carver Model:** The Board's role is to establish governance policies and monitor CEO/ED on compliance with policies (Set the "ends" and "executive limitations" - leave the "means" to CEO/ ED). Well-established not for profits, well-staffed, often larger NFPs.
